



Gold STUDENT MINISTRY ARCHITECTS PLAN INCLUDES:

Weekly Programming

- Full programming oversight and execution of weekly student ministry gatherings throughout each semester.

Events

- Planning and execution of 2-3 connecting events per semester. These will take place during standard programming date/time with a focus on fun and inviting friends. (i.e. Christmas Party, Passover Seder, Glow In The Dark event, etc.)
- Planning and execution of 1 overnight retreat/camp/conference each semester. These events will be collaborative events and offered to every SMA church in your area.
- Planning & execution of 1-2 local day activities each semester. (i.e. Corn Maze, Paintball, Carowinds, SkyZone, etc.)

All Events are contingent on a minimum number of volunteers and students signing up by the deadline.

Campus Ministry/Discipleship

- SMA will work with your students to connect them with existing Youth Commission Bible clubs or work to establish clubs with your students at their local Middle School or High School campus.

Parent Ministry

- Assistance in planning and leading one parent calendar meeting per semester.
- Planning and execution of one parent training/seminar per semester.
- Weekly emails to parents (monthly during summer months) with resources and key information.

Volunteer Development

- Assistance in creating and implementing volunteer roles.
- Assistance in planning and leading one volunteer training per year.
- Lead volunteers through weekly communication & monthly training huddles throughout both semesters.

Church is responsible for recruiting volunteer team.

Summer Ministry

- Full programming oversight for a 6-week discipleship program for students.
- Planning & execution of 2-3 local day activities.
- Planning & execution of students to attend a local summer camp for a week.
