Play

Play a game together.

BEAR, NINJA, COP



This game is a full-body remix of Rock, Paper, Scissors. Everyone in the room should stand back-to-back with a partner. The "game master" will then count down by naming the three character options ("bear... ninja... cop... GO!") On "GO!" everyone in the room will turn around and act out one of the three characters. The bear beats the ninja, the ninja beats the cop, and the cop beats the bear.

The losing player is out, and the winner finds a new partner. The last person remaining is the winner of the game!

Ask God For His Will To Be Done In The Following Areas:

Club Time

Pray that God will speak to everyone in the room through His Word.

Group Needs

Take time to discuss and pray over the personal needs and requests of those in attendance.

School Community

Ask God to move in situations that are unique to your school and community.



LIE #1: YOUR FEELINGS MUST BE FOLLOWED

Luke 4:1-4 ESV

"And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness (2) for forty days, being tempted by the devil. And he ate nothing during those days. And when they were ended, he was hungry. (3) The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread." (4) And Jesus answered him, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone."



3 Keys To Fighting Tempting Feelings

Key #1: Trust

Unsurprisingly, Jesus was hungry after going 40 days without eating. His feeling of hunger must have been significant, but He recognized that He was following the leading of the Holy Spirit (Luke 4:1). Similarly, when we allow God to lead our steps, we can trust that He will help us navigate strong feelings and emotions that are in opposition to His will.

Key #2: Vision

The enemy tempted Jesus to turn a nearby stone into bread (Luke 4:3). He was able to overcome this lie because He knew that His Father's "big picture" mission for Him was more significant than having a bite to eat. When we truly recognize that God wants to use us to impact our world, it helps us to obey Him in ordinary moments.

Key #3: Scripture

Jesus combatted Satan's lies with Scripture (Luke 4:4). We can only overcome lies when we know the truth, and the Bible is the only perfect source of truth we have. It is essential that we spend time reading, studying and applying God's Word.

Consider This Before You Leave



In the same way that Jesus felt hunger in the wilderness, we will face moments when we are tempted to forfeit our calling and embrace tempting feelings. In these moments, it is essential for us to trust God, consider our purpose and fill our hearts with Scripture.
